Mathematics

- Estimate the volume and capacity of objects - eg. Using 1cm³ blocks to build a cuboid.
- Solve problems involving converting between units of time.
- Use all four operations to solve problems involving measure, using decimal notation including scaling.
- Use the properties of rectangles to deduce related facts and find missing lengths and angles.
- Distinguish between regular and irregular polygons based upon reasoning about equal sides and angles.
- Identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation, using the appropriate language, and know that the shape has not changed.
- Solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in a line graph.
- Complete, read and interpret information in tables, including timetables.
