

# Behaviour Climber

'Be at the top, stay at the top!'



## Stage 1 pale yellow

### Behaviour

- Calling out in class
- Not completing homework
- Not listening
- Restless behaviour
- Running in the school
- Name calling
- Rough play

### Sanctions

- Verbal warning
- Work on your own

If this continues then you move to Stage 2.

## Stage 2 yellow

### Behaviour

All continued actions from stage 1. If 3 warnings given, you move straight to stage 3.

### Sanctions

- Missing part of privileges/golden time etc
- Staying in at break (5 minutes)
- 3 warnings
- SMSA's to give yellow card

## Stage 3 orange

### Behaviour

- Unacceptable language in class and outside on the playground.
- Boisterous behaviour
- Physical reaction to any situation
- Constant pushing in the line
- Constant rough play

### Sanctions

- Missing privileges
- Missing whole break time
- Behaviour card
- SMSA's to give orange card
- Talk to Deputy Head

## Stage 4 red

### Behaviour

- Persistent Stage 3 actions. Also
- Constant aggressive behaviour
  - Racism
  - Bullying continually
  - Damage to property
  - Stealing

### Sanctions

- Removal of all privileges
- Removal from class
- Limited play
- Behaviour card

## Rewards

### Class rewards include:

**VIP of the week**  
(very important pupil)  
Rewarded for excellent effort and progress during that week. For example, following the class rules in/out of the classroom, positive attitude towards learning etc.

**Writer of the week**  
Rewarded for excellent effort and progress in writing during that week. For example, achieving writing targets, improving handwriting, etc.

**Termly Teacher Award**  
Rewarded for displaying consistent outstanding academic effort, behaviour and showing progress.

**Star Chart Awards**  
Rewarded for following the classroom rules.  
Silver Certificate: 10 stars,  
Gold Certificate: 20 stars,  
Book Award: 30 stars.

**Termly Handwriting Award**  
Rewarded for consistently using neat, cursive handwriting. A certificate is also awarded for 'most improved' handwriting.

### Lunchtime rewards include:

**Milk/Register Monitors**  
Rewarded for milk distribution.

**Lunch Time Awards**  
Gold cards to be given to pupils for displaying good behaviour and following playground promises. For example, finishing lunch, tidying up, being kind, lining up sensibly.

**Healthy Eating Award**  
Rewarded for bringing/eating a healthy lunch. A healthy eating sticker is awarded.

### Other rewards include:

**Librarians**  
Rewarded for service to the library during lunchtimes.

**Assembly Contribution**  
Rewarded for taking part in key stage assemblies each day.

**Attendance Award**  
Rewarded for 100% attendance during the academic year.

**Deputy Heads Award**  
Rewarded for 'Wow' moments.
