## Re: Update on Roadworks on Springfield Road

I wanted to take a moment to update you on the current traffic situation on Springfield Road and the steps that our schools have taken to address the issue.

As you know, Springfield Road traffic has been causing significant inconvenience for everyone involved. We understand that we are all being tested in these challenging circumstances, and we must be patient and act as good role models for our children during such situations. These circumstances can be frustrating, but it is crucial that we approach this situation with patience and understanding and prioritise the safety of our children.

Since the beginning of this week, our schools have been working tirelessly to find a resolution to the traffic problem. We have been in constant communication with D&G Utilities Ltd., and after a couple of days of delay, they have now opened both lanes for the easy flow of traffic. This is a positive step towards addressing the issue.

In addition, we have contacted local councillors who are liaising with National Highways to ensure that no roadworks are planned during term time. Cllr Kamal Preet Kaur has been very supportive and arranged for us to raise the concerns to the relevant parties.

Furthermore, the schools have raised concerns about the traffic light timings with TfL and the Hillingdon Road Safety Department. They have assured us they will implement measures to resolve the issues.

We have planned staggered timings for the primary phases today to ease traffic flow. The details of these timings have been emailed to all primary parents in a separate message.

I want to assure you that we are actively working with all relevant agencies to address the concerns as soon as possible. We understand the importance of road safety and the security of our community in all circumstances. We urge you to adhere to road safety guidelines and be vigilant when commuting to and from the school premises.

As an esteemed educational institution, we are responsible for fostering an environment that promotes safety and well-being. With young children present, it is of utmost importance that we all abide by road safety measures and demonstrate exemplary behaviour when driving in and around the school vicinity.
