Despite our efforts, we were unable to prevent these road works from taking place, this is due to a decision which has been made by the studios and the council.

The roadworks are expected to last until Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> January. We sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused and any potential traffic situation that may arise as a result. Please be assured that the school is working diligently to find solutions to minimise disruptions for our pupils, staff and families.

We are working closely with the contractors and council to find a solution to how we can best manage the traffic and will share the information with parents with further updates.


