To help develop your son/daughter's understanding of their potential future career path we have arranged a visit to UCAS Discovery London 2024 event at Excel in London.

The event is on **Tuesday 19th March 2024 between 9:30am to 11:30am**. The students will enhance their learning of opportunities available to them Post 16 education. Students will have the opportunity to put their questions to the UK's leading universities and compare their options side by side, all under one roof.

Students will make their own way to the Excel in London by public transport and will meet me outside from 9:15am. Your son/daughter should be home by 12.30pm, unless they choose to do something else afterwards locally, which should be discussed with you beforehand. I will be in attendance at Excel for the duration of the event.

There is no cost to this event. Students will need an Oyster card or debit/credit card to enable them to travel on buses and tubes. The trip will be fully risk assessed.

Students with allergies, asthma or medications must be clearly stated. If your child suffers from Asthma or requires an Epipen (x2), please ensure that the appropriate medication/inhaler is provided otherwise they will not be allowed on the trip. If your child no longer requires their inhaler/Epipen, but still appears on our medical records, please contact the Welfare Office to amend your child's records (medical evidence must be provided prior to the trip).

Please ensure you complete and sign the attached Parent Consent Form and **return it to Mrs Bhogal** no later than 5th March 2024. If your son/daughter chooses not to go to the event then they must be in school as normal.

Students are not expected to return to school. However, for Period 6 and Period 7 the Subject Teachers will be uploading work on Google Classroom for their timetabled lessons and the students are expected to complete the set tasks at home during the afternoon.
