

## Literacy

In our narrative unit pupils will be reading ***We're Going on a Bear Hunt*** and completing activities such as character descriptions, story sequencing and retelling. In our ***Poetry*** unit pupils will learn the appropriate features and write their own poems.

## Science

Our science topic this half-term is ***Identifying Animals***. Pupils will be identifying and naming a variety of common UK mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians. As part of this unit pupils will identify and sort carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Pupils will also have a greater understanding of how to take care of animals.

## PSHCE

Our PSHCE topic is ***Celebrating Differences***. Children will learn to appreciate that whilst we are all different we are also equal and entitled to the same respect and rights. This will tie in with our anti-bullying week, the theme of which is "All Different, All Equal."

## Maths

**Shape:** pupils will be recognising and naming common 2D and 3D shapes.

**Geometry:** pupils will be describing position, direction and movement.

**Number & Place Value:** pupils will be identifying and representing numbers using objects and a number line.

**Multiplication and Division** (learning strategies to solve multiplication and division sums.)

## Computing

***Treasure Hunter***: pupils will be programming a toy to move around a map to find buried treasure.

## History /Geography

This half-term our Geography topic is ***Where do I Live***. Pupils will be learning that we all have an address and will create maps to show their journeys to and from school. They will identify places they visit in their local community. Then they will recognise ways of changing the environment and discuss ways to make an area safer.

## Art/DT

***Paper Art***: pupils will be exploring different types of paper used in art and create a collage.

They will also work with tissue paper to create a piece of artwork. Pupils will use paper to create beads and use paper mache to create a sculpture.

## Punjabi/Sikh Studies

***Punjabi***: pupils will be understanding general instructions in Punjabi, recognising the alphabet, learning the correct formation of each letter and being introduced to Mukta

***Sikh Studies***, pupils will be practicing the 3<sup>rd</sup> Pauree of Japji Sahib Paath and exploring the Sakhis from Guru Nanak Dev Ji's life.
