RE: Year 7 Beck Theatre Trip – December 2022

To celebrate a successful first term, the Academy is planning a trip for Year 7 students. Seats have been reserved at the Beck Theatre to watch the pantomime 'Cinderella'. The year group will be divided into three separate groups to watch the performance on either **13th, 14th or 15th December 2022 at 2:00pm**. Further details will be provided nearer the time. Students will travel to the theatre by public bus in small groups, accompanied by members of staff. The show is expected to last approximately two hours and we will ask for students to be either collected or make their own way home from the Beck Theatre when the pantomime **finishes at 4:00pm**. The Beck Theatre is located on Grange Road, Hayes UB3 2UE.

The cost of this trip is **£12.50 per student** and payment must be made via School Gateway. **Students who have been Free School Meals within the last 6 years are not required to pay for the trip as it will be funded from their Pupil Premium allocation. However, you will still need to complete the attached parent consent form to confirm your child's attendance on the trip (your child's name will not show on School Gateway payment system).**

Students are not required to wear school uniform on the day of their trip but must wear suitable clothing and head covering. Students will attend school lessons from 8:00am to Period 5. We will depart from school at 1:00pm and travel by public bus from Springfield Road to Beck Theatre. **Students should bring a packed lunch on the day to eat before the performance begins. If your child receives a Free School Meal then the school will provide a packed lunch on the day or your child can bring their own lunch if they wish.**

Students will require an Oyster Card if travelling home by themselves. To secure a place, please make payment of £12.50 via School Gateway. Once you have made the payment, the completed consent form should be returned to your child's Form Tutor **no later than Friday 7th October 2022.**

Students with allergies, asthma or medications must be clearly stated. If your child suffers from Asthma or requires an EpiPen, please ensure that the appropriate medication is provided otherwise they will not be allowed on the trip. If your child no longer requires their inhaler/epipen, but still appears on our medical records, please contact the Welfare Office to amend your child's records (medical evidence must be provided prior to the trip).
