# Year 2 Autumn Curriculum

We hope you had a lovely Summer holiday. We know the pupils certainly deserved a break after all their hard work last academic year. We would like to take this opportunity to congratulate pupils for their success in their phonics screening test, it was a fantastic achievement for them and the skills they learnt will continue to serve them well as they embark upon year 2. Please find below some information regarding what your child will be learning this term in addition to other important information.

### Curriculum coverage

In literacy, pupils will be reading I want my hat back by Jon Klassen in our narrative units and writing their own stories using those popular texts as their stimulus. Later in the term, we will look at the features of acrostic poems in addition to newspaper reports in our non-fiction unit. We will also have a strong focus on basic writing skills including capital letters and full stops, writing in the cursive style and using words types such as adjectives and would appreciate reinforcement at home in these areas.

In maths pupils will learn to understanding the value of numbers, e.g. understanding that in the number 36 the number 3 represents 30. A strong foundation in place value is necessary for pupils to thrive in maths throughout the year as we progress to learning more complex strategies to solve problems. Pupils will also learn about measuring length and width using centimeters in addition to developing strategies to solve basic arithmetic questions in the areas of addition and subtraction.

- Homework will be given every Friday. It is due back on Wednesday and must be completed in full. We encourage parents to help their children with homework and ensure they are completing it to a high standard.
- Reading books will be given every Friday. They are due back on Wednesday. Please ensure you have signed/ticked the reading record so that your child can receive a new book to take home on Friday.
- Spellings will be given on Friday. A spelling test will take place every Thursday.

### **Important Information**

- The school day commences at 8:15am. Please ensure your child's timely arrival at school every morning.
- Please ensure your child wears the correct school uniform. We'd like to emphasise that trainers are not allowed- your child must wear smart black shoes.
- Please ensure all items of your child's uniform and P.E kit are labelled with their name. This will help re-locate any missing items in the event that an item goes missing.
- Please provide your child with a water bottle which they must bring to school every day.
