Parent / Guardian Home Learning Guide

As a guardian / parent, you will receive email summaries showing your student's progress in their Google classrooms.

Note: You can only receive summaries for students using Classroom with a G Suite account. For details, see [About Classroom user accounts](#).

You can choose the frequency of the emails, such as daily or weekly.

Note: Daily means Monday to Friday. You won't receive email summaries on Saturdays or Sundays.

You can unsubscribe or remove yourself from Classroom at any time.

Guardian / parent emails will include:

- **Missing work**—Work that's late at the time the email was sent
- **Upcoming work**—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or work that's due in the **upcoming week** (for weekly emails)
- **Class activity**—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently **posted by our subject teachers**
- Subject Leaders / SLT may also email parents / guardians to support pupils with their learning

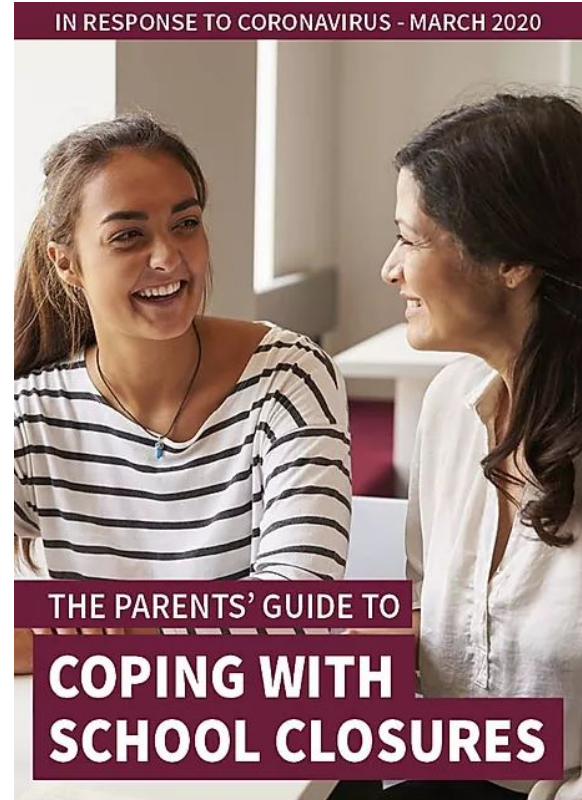


5 Quick Steps

1. **Motivate** and **encourage positively** your child to access their home learning through Google Classroom and ask questions to their teachers this can be completed swiftly and with relative ease.
2. Set a learning schedule / routine to mirror the school routine, this will make the transition from school to home learning much smoother
3. **Set time aside** each day based on the amount of home learning your child
4. Make sure that School work is the **only thing on the agenda** during this timeframe.#
5. **Short Breaks / Lunches** - It is very important to include breaks during the school work time. Research shows that taking breaks when working makes children more productive.
