Minet Country Park will be closed on 7th July to enable coaches to efficiently collect secondary students for the up and coming trips day. There will be approximately 15 coaches arriving between 8:45am and 10:00am and we want to ensure they are able to leave in sufficient time to get to the venues.

On 7th July, there will also be limited access to Springfield Road itself other than for GNSA Primary and NPS parents, as we need to keep the road as clear as possible to allow a swift transit to the trip venues. We request that alternative methods of coming to school are explored for this day, whether it be public transport or walking.

Sixth Form students will be on duty along Springfield Road and the path leading from the bridge in Minet Country Park (Avondale Road side) from 8:30am to ensure students are making their way safely to school.

Registration for Years 7-10 will be at 8:45am and students will return to school between 5:00 – 5:30pm. The school will send messages via School Gateway with any updates throughout the day.
