Dear Parent/Carer

The NEU has announced two further days of industrial action on Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July. I am getting in touch to give you as much notice as possible about our arrangements for each phase/year group which are outlined below.

Nanaksar Primary – all children attend school as normal on both days. The school will be open.

GNSA Primary Phase - all children attend school as normal on Wednesday 5th July.

On Friday 7th July there will be partial closures; the following classes will be closed on this date:

3 Bhai Kanhaiya

4 Pankhurst

GNSA Secondary Phase:

On Friday 7th July - there will be no change to the current arrangements. The secondary phase will be open and the Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 school trips will take place as planned. Year 12 pupils will attend school to take part in the activities as planned.

There will be a partial closure on Wednesday 5th July 2023, please see details below:

Year 12 – school will remain open. Pupils are to attend lessons as normal and remain in Private Study at other times. If their teacher is not in school for their Period 6 and 7 lessons, then pupils will be permitted to have home study after lunch, otherwise they will continue with lessons all day.

Years 7, 8 & 10 - school will remain open. All pupils must come to school with revision resources and a reading book; in addition to their usual books. It is crucial at this stage that pupils are prepared to carry out independent revision in the event of staff absence. The Year 10 Duke of Edinburgh residential trip and expedition will continue as planned for those pupils taking part.

Year 9 – school will be closed on 5th July and pupils will remain at home. Work will be uploaded to Google Classroom for the lessons for the day and pupils will be expected to complete the work set.

If your son/daughter is in Year 9 and is vulnerable (please contact the school if you require clarification here), or has an EHCP, please contact the school if you would like them to attend as normal, and we will make the necessary arrangements to accommodate this. If your son/daughter is in Year 9 and is entitled to Free School meals, please contact the secondary school office in advance if you would like them to collect a packed lunch.

We are working closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation and will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further.
